Year C (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Advent starts with a call to be ready—not ready for the coming of the baby Jesus at Christmas but to be standing ready for the coming of Christ on the Last Day. This is the Christian 'Hope' and 'Joy' that, at the end of time, we shall all be gathered together in the Kingdom of Heaven. This season is a joyful one but it is also one where we just take a moment to ask ourselves whether we are ready. Are we ready, in our hearts, to greet the Lord? Only when we are ready for Jesus to come again are we truly ready to celebrate Christmas with authenticity and truth.
