**NEW LECTIONARY**. The Lectionary is the book which contains the readings which are proclaimed at Mass and as from today, we will be using this new translation. The new edition uses the English Standard Version- Catholic Edition for the readings and the Abbey Psalms and Canticles for the Responsorial Psalms.

If you are already in the habit of using a missal, you might want to consider replacing it with one which has the new scriptural text. If you do not currently use one, having your own missal is a great way of helping to grow attentive to both Scripture and the Mass, as we read through the Sunday readings in advance and begin a habit of praying with the Readings. If anyone wants to buy a new Sunday Missal, there is list available at the repository for orders.

**CONTACTLESS MACHINE AND GIFT AID** The new system is via Stripe payments. If you had set up gift aid on the old machine, you will be asked to re-enter your details. Once this is done, it will not need repeating. You will be prompted for your name, number of house, and postcode which should be done in upper case. Once this has been done, the machine will recognise your card the next time to make a payment and automatically gift aid the transaction. Gift Aid can increase the value of your donations by 25%. Payments may appear on bank statements as 'Stripe'. To see a video of how to set up Gift aid please see the following <u>link</u>.

**CONTACTLESS GIVING** To use the contactless machine, you need to wave your card over the small box to the right of the main screen. The machine has options for Sunday Collection, Second Collection, Repository and other collections as the need arises. Donations will show as "Stripe" on bank statements. If the machine fails to accept your **contactless** card payment, then please insert the card and complete the transaction by pin. This should be indicated on the screen. Contactless payments by mobile phone should not be affected.
