1ST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

REFLECTION FROM FR. ANTHONY. During this season of Advent, we have now shifted our attention to the Incarnation, the birth of Christ, God becoming man, which we will celebrate at Christmas. We need some time to prepare for this great mystery. Advent is a time of joyful preparation, where we are called to be renewed in Christ.

To help us achieve this goal at the end of Advent, the Catholic Church, through the liturgy, puts before us three major themes, or three types of Advents: Christ has come, Christ is coming, and Christ will come. Let us make good use of this season of Advent to prepare well for the coming of Christ at the moment, but also to keep our heads up high as we look forward to the Second Coming with hopeful expectation.

GOSPEL. Luke 21:25-28,34-36. "That day will be sprung on you suddenly like a trap."

COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS. Starting in Advent, the faithful will have the opportunity to receive Communion under both kinds (the host and Precious Blood) at Sunday Masses. The "meaning" of Communion is most clearly signified when given under both kinds. However, as our faith teaches, communion received under one kind, such as the Host alone, receives the whole and entire Christ. The choice is left to the communicant.

APPEAL FOR CROSS. Urgent repairs are needed to secure the cross on the north end of the church. Work will begin shortly. It will cost around £2,000. We have raised £1,222.44 so far. Thank you! We would appreciate your generosity towards this urgent repair.
