REFLECTION FROM FR. ANTHONY. We have an important role and mission of spreading the kingdom of God in our midst. A kingdom of truth, life, holiness, grace, justice, love and peace. Christ, the King and Lord of the whole universe, made himself the servant of all. For us Christians, we are called to serve each other, for to *"reign is to serve him."* In particular, we are called to serve those who are poor, those who are suffering, those who are downcast and those who feel marginalised and rejected.

We, the People of God, fulfill our royal dignity by a life in keeping with its vocation to serve with Christ. For the criteria on the last day of judgement will be if we were of service with Christ in serving Christ in the hungry, in the thirsty, in the strangers, in the naked, in the sick, and in the prison. We are called to go beyond our comfort zones and go over and beyond ourselves to be a community of service to each other and those people we encounter.

COMMUNION UNDER BOTH KINDS. Starting in Advent, the faithful will have the opportunity to receive Communion under both kinds (the host and Precious Blood) at Sunday Masses. The "meaning" of Communion is most clearly signified when given under both kinds. However, as our faith teaches, communion received under one kind, such as the Host alone, receives the whole and entire Christ. The choice is left to the communicant.

APPEAL FOR CROSS. Urgent repairs are needed to secure the cross on the north end of the church. Work will begin shortly. It will cost around £2,000. We have raised £463 so far. Thank you! We would appreciate your generosity towards this repair.
