Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Today's readings are about 'family'. The traditional idea of 'family' has been under threat for some time now. But that is the structure and foundation of society planned by God. God Himself is 'family' in the Holy Trinity; and God the Son came into the world and lived in a family with earthly parents. Families get broken because of human frailty. It is our calling and our duty under God to try not to loose this valuable gift from Him.
