Sunday Reflection

THEME: BLESSED IS THE FRUIT OF YOUR WOMB

We have been reflecting this Advent on various ways we can prepare ourselves to receive the coming Messiah at Christmas. We have come to the last week of this preparation as we light the last purple candle signifying love. That love of self and of Christ called us to a further preparation last week when we celebrated the sacrament of confession, during our two penitential services at St. Joseph and Corpus Christ. This gave us the opportunity for the best preparation in welcoming Christ at Christmas. Today, I would like us to reflect on Elizabeth's words to Mary at the visitation: Blessed is the fruit of your womb.

The gospel scene of today is a continuation of the annunciation story of Mary's conception of Jesus. After the Angel Gabriel told her she was to conceive and bear a son, he also informed her that her cousin Elizabeth was in her sixth month of pregnancy. Mary could not keep her joy hidden. She left immediately to visit her cousin. At the house of Zechariah, many mysterious things happened because of Christ. As God himself, he came to renew us and to bring us what was absent. We are told that as soon as Elizabeth heard Mary's greetings, the child in her womb leapt for joy. The direct effect of this on Elizabeth was that she was filled with the Holy Spirit and then prophesied "Of all women you are the most Blessed and blessed is the fruit of your womb" (Lk 1:42).

The blessed fruit of Mary's womb is Jesus. He is coming for you and me. Just as his presence in Mary's womb filled Elizabeth with the Holy Spirit, so too he wants to fill us with the gift of the Holy Spirit this Christmas. To be filled with the Holy

Spirit entails complete surrender to God and allowing the Holy Spirit to lead us in the way he wants to. It means also purifying ourselves so that the Holy Spirit can dwell in us. This purification comes in the Sacrament of confession. We need to ask ourselves whether we have made used of this sacrament as we prepare for Christmas.

Also, just as the first reading narrates, he is coming to save us and he himself will be peace (Micah 5:4). We each truly need him to bring peace into our lives and our world. Many of us might be troubled for one reason or another and this might have taken away our peace. We need to turn to Jesus today to ask him to help us with the gift of peace. This can only be done if we surrender everything into his hands and allow him to act in our lives.

May the Blessed fruit of Mary's womb, Jesus, come to us in a special way this Christmas. May he bring us peace and the gift of the Holy Spirit in our lives.
