

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Year C (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. In this week's Gospel, we hear how the Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus and a voice from heaven proclaimed "You are My Son, the Beloved". This happened as Jesus was baptised in the River Jordan and all Christians follow His example, receiving baptism to start their Christian life. The very same Holy Spirit descends on each of us and helps us to live our lives, guiding us so that we may remain faithful to our calling as the baptised Body of Christ.

First Reading:	Isaiah 40:1-5,9-11 — The glory of LORD shall be revealed and all flesh shall see it together
Responsorial Psalm:	Bless the LORD, O my soul! My God, how great You are! (Psalm 104)
Second Reading:	Titus 2:11-14,3:4-7 — He saved us by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit
Gospel Acclamation:	Alleluia, alleluia! He who is mightier than I is coming, said John. He will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire. Alleluia! (cf. Luke 3:16)
Gospel Reading:	Luke 3:16-16,21-22 — When Jesus had been baptised and was praying, the heavens were opened
Communion Antiphon:	Behold the One of who John said: I have seen and testified that this is the Son of God. (John 1:32,34)
