Year C (Psalter Week 2)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Today's readings describe Jesus as the 'bridegroom' of the Church. Just as a bridegroom rejoices in His bride, so Jesus rejoices in His Church—you and me. In the Eucharist, Holy Spirit, transforms bread and wine and makes them something new: the Body and Blood of Jesus and He does this for us. The Holy Spirit does so many things for us and it is from Him that we receive a variety of gifts, which we are to use for the mission of the Church.

First Reading: Isaiah 62:1-5 — The bridegroom rejoices over the bride

Responsorial Psalm: Proclaim the wonders of the LORD among all the peoples (Psalm 96)

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 — The one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as He wills

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! God called us through the gospel,

so that we may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. Alleluia! (cf. 2 Thessalonians 2:14)

Gospel Reading: John 2:1-11 — This, the first of His signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee

Communion Antiphon: You have prepared a table before me,

and how precious is the chalice that quenches my thirst. (cf Psalm 22:5)


