PARISH WORKS Recently the parish has undergone a full review by external assessors of our Fire, Health and Safety, and Water (Legionella) risks. Although the parish was found to be satisfactory on all fronts, we are required to install a Fire Alarm in the church, and additional fire exit. We need to upgrade the current alarm system in the hall, add illuminated fire exits in both church and hall and to add emergency lighting in the church. As you can appreciate all this comes with a hefty price tag. To this end we are putting a hold on the roof fundraising, and will be fundraising for these other important and urgently needed works instead.

CLOSER TO CHRIST CAMPAIGN. We are pleased to report that the parish has received its first rebate from the CTC campaign, of £4.700. Thank you to those who have and are supporting this initiative.

A FIRST HOLY COMMUNION INFORMATION SESSION will be held in the church hall, straight after 09:30 Mass, today, Sunday 26th January. Registration forms will be handed out at this session and members of the FHC Team will be available to answer any questions on the programme

CAFOD IN OUR PARISH Thank you for your prayers and continuing support for CAFOD through your donations (refreshments on Sunday mornings, Taizé, cake sales) weekly envelope collection for our current project, our two Family Fast Days and appeals. In 2024 we raised £3936.06. Thank you also for all your online donations and direct debits (amount unknown). We started our new project "Hands on Madhupur" in Bangladesh in January 2024 and raised £2066.31. This will help CAFOD'S experts on the ground work alongside families as they fight for their land and stand up against injustice. Many thanks also for your generous response to our TWO FAMILY FAST DAYS where £1650 was raised through the envelope collection alone and your response to the two online appeals (the crisis in Sudan in April and the conflict in the Middle East in October). Finally the cake and craft sale in response to CAFOD'S Christmas appeal raised £219.75.
