Sunday 5 January 2025 : The Epiphany of the Lord

The Epiphany hymn *We three kings of orient are* includes a verse on each of the three gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh, neatly summarising the significance of each of the wise men's gifts. "Born a king on Bethlehem plain: gold I bring to crown him again": Jesus is King and alone belongs on the throne of our lives – all else must give place to Him. "Frankincense to offer have I; incense owns a Deity nigh": Jesus is God and alone is worthy of all praise – our purpose in life is worship, the joyful celebration of God. "Myrrh is mine, its bitter perfume breathes a life of gathering gloom": Jesus offers himself to the Father for our salvation – in Christ we learn to order our whole selves to the Father and to make of our whole lives a living sacrifice of prayer and praise in the Spirit.
