FR. ANTHONY'S REFLECTION. Every night, the Church, through Night Prayer, puts on our lips the Nunc dimittis, also known as the Song of Simeon or the Canticle of Simeon: "Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation that you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel."
