THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

FR. ANTHONY'S REFLECTION. Through baptism, we are incorporated into Christ and are formed as God's people. This sacrament pardons all sins, rescues us from the power of darkness, and brings us to the dignity of adopted children. We are a new creation through water and the Holy Spirit. In such a way we are pleasing to God. Baptism is a sacrament of faith, in which we respond to the Gospel.

Although the celebration of baptism is a 'one-off event,' in fact, our baptismal graces deepen over our pilgrimage journey during this life and fully flourish in the next life. The feast of the Baptism of the Lord is the end of the Christmas liturgical season. There is a fittingness that we end this season with this feast day, as we celebrated at Christmas the start of the paschal mystery, with the incarnation and nativity of our Lord, the baptism of Jesus reminds us that we are incorporated into this mystery through the celebration of baptism.
