Year C (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. God calls us to action. He is constantly asking us to spread His Word throughout Hayling Island. Jesus transformed his apostles from fisher-men into fishers-of-men. Likewise we are transformed by the Holy Spirit from passive 'receivers' into active 'apostles' and 'prophets', called by the Jesus to proclaim the saving power of the Father to every living soul on Hayling Island. Like Isaiah, we are touched with the burning fire of the Holy Spirit. When the Lord asks who His messenger will be, the congregation of St Patrick's need to cry as one "Here I am, Lord, send me!"


