REFLECTION

The Jubilee Icon

Created by the artist Mulugest Araya to celebrate the 2025 Pilgrims of Hope, this icon was produced with CAFOD partners from St Mary's College Wukro, Adigrat diocese in Tigray, northern Ethiopia, who have expertise in iconography.

The artist interprets Jesus' teaching of healing and liberation in the Synagogue from Luke 4:16-21, which refers to Isaiah 61:1-2. The crowd gathers to listen to Jesus: men, women and children, old and young. Listening attentively, their body language shows they are engaged with the Word of God. Their eyes are fixed on Jesus, who is looking out into the world. His gaze encompasses all people, not just this crowd, and his teaching is for all time. The act of 'seeing' is a predominant theme in Ethiopian icons.

Jesus wears a golden halo to show his divinity as the Son of God. Jesus raises his right hand to show that he is teaching. Jesus holds the Holy Bible in his left hand opened at the Scripture text written in Ge'ez (an Ethiopian Semitic language). The rainbow is a symbol of God's covenantal hope with all people, bridging the Old and New Testaments.

The Icon will be travelling to dioceses and parishes across the country during the Jubilee Year 2025.
