Sunday 9 February 2025 : Fifth Sunday of the Year

As we celebrate this Holy Year of Hope 2025, our Gospel today invites us to look back to the last Jubilee Year 2000, which Pope St John Paul II closed with these words: "our hearts ring out with the words of Jesus when one day, after speaking to the crowds from Simon's boat, he invited the Apostle to 'put out into the deep' for a catch: *Duc in altum* (*Lk* 5:4). Peter and his first companions trusted Christ's words, and cast the nets. 'When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish' (*Lk* 5:6). *Duc in altum*! These words ring out for us today, and they invite us to remember the past with gratitude, to live the present with enthusiasm and to look forward to the future with confidence: 'Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and for ever' (*Heb* 13:8)."
