In this Sunday's Gospel, the Lord says: "Give to everyone who begs from you." But please bear in mind that in the ancient world there was (1) no welfare state and (2) no hard drugs. Today, our moral duty is to direct street beggars to statutory services provided for the homeless by the local authority and partner charities, such as the Portsmouth Rough Sleepers' Hub, open every day at Elm Grove. Street beggars are almost invariably drug addicts, the most proximate victims of a global criminal drug trafficking complex, whose other victims include: children exploited by County Lines gangs, migrants used as drug mules, and modern slaves forced to grow drugs by violent cartels. Money given to beggars on the street funds money laundering, gun running, human trafficking and modern slavery. Beggars with cash attract drug dealers into our neighbourhood, so protect your children and grandchildren from drugs by not giving money to beggars
