FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

9th March 2025 AD Year C (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Our Bible readings this week remind us that God always hears our prayers and will lead us into a promised land of peace if we will only follow Him. There is no temptation that cannot be overcome if we open our hearts to the Holy Spirit, who tells us that Jesus is Lord, raised for our salvation by the Father. Just as God recued the Jews from slavery in Egypt so, in Jesus, He is always with us and rescues us from slavery to sin.
