Welcome to St Patrick's Church. In today's readings we hear how the Lord will transfigure us. He is ever-ready to transform our lives. He is as faithful to us as the Father was to Abraham and with faith in God and belief in His saving power we discover how good it is to be in His presence.

First Reading:	Genesis 15:12,17-18 — God enters into a covenant with Abram, the man of faith
Responsorial Psalm:	The LORD is my light and my salvation. (Psalm 27 : R.1a)
Second Reading:	Philippians 3:17-4:1 — Christ will configure us to His glorious body
