**Bishop Philip** wrote of a visit on 18<sup>th</sup> March: I was very pleased to visit St. Thomas More's Catholic Primary School. In the picture is Headteacher Mr. Jeff Sendall, Mrs. Rebecca Hill, one of two Deputy Heads, and Mr. Paul Baker, Chair of Governors and Fr. Joe Gruszkiewicz, parish priest of Havant. The school serves the parishes of St. Joseph's, Havant, St. Michael's, Leigh Park and St. Patrick's, Hayling Island and Canon Gerard Flynn and Fr. Mark Whiting are regular visitors. It is a one and a half form entry school with 351 pupils, 61% of whom are Catholic. Mr. Sendall has been at the school since he qualified as a teacher. He is the chair of the Primary Catholic Partnership School-Centred Initial Teacher **Training** Southampton (PCP SCITT) which offers primary teacher training courses. The school has its own small chapel in the grounds. Fr. Joe brought the Blessed Sacrament over to the hall where, with everyone assembled we had a period of Eucharistic Adoration, concluding Benediction. The children had a real sense of prayer and joined in well. I then met with the Head, the Deputy Head and the Chair of Governors to discuss the Catholic ethos of the school and how best to help children develop a personal relationship with God. Please pray for everyone at St. Thomas More's. It was a joy to visit. In the conversation we had, I was struck by how much the school strives to put prayer and worship at the heart of its daily life and to build a family atmosphere by a partnership between school, parish and home.
