### Sunday 16 March 2025 : Second Sunday of Lent

The Old Testament reading for this Sunday describes the covenant made by God with Abraham. What we call the Old Testament is a history of the covenant relationship between God and his people, through which we can understand the meaning of the new and eternal covenant in Christ. In the ancient world the parties to a covenant would pass between the halves of sacrificed animals as a sign that they staked their lives on faithfulness to the covenant (Gen 15:17 cf Jer 34:18). God's undertaking to Abraham is a prophecy, to be fulfilled in the total self-offering and self-gift of Jesus on the Cross, the "departure" he discusses with Moses and Elijah at the Transfiguration.
