Refused tell them and left for dead. Recovered and rejoined St Avitus at La Perche. Appointed Abbot of Brou and ordained a priest although he preferred the life of a monk. Then made the Bishop of Chartres a position of power. Wisely carried out many reforms and was involved in Fifth Council of Orleans and the Second Council of Paris. He died after a long illness on 14 th March 558
