**The Scriptures for the Easter Vigil** tell the unfolding story of our Redemption. The odd numbered readings from the Old Testament will be used. On Easter Sunday morning the readings are:

**First reading** Acts 10:34.37-43 We hear part of an early sermon of Peter.

**Second reading** 1 Corinthians 5:6b-8 Through our baptism we already share in the risen life of Christ, through a hidden and mysterious way.

**Gospel reading** John 20:1-9 The disciples discover that Jesus' tomb is empty. They begin to grasp what the Scriptures had foretold; that Jesus would rise from the dead.

The Proper for the Easter Vigil begins on page 223 of the Parish Mass Book  
and for Easter Morning the Proper begins on page 252.

The Prayer of the Church is Proper for the Octave of Easter.
