1st June 2025 AD Year C (Psalter Week 3)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. On Thursday we celebrated the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ into heaven. Now, with the whole Church, we wait and cry out "Come, Lord Jesus!" We await His second coming and, like the deacon and first Christian martyr St Stephen, in faith we see Him standing at the right hand of the Father. At this place of Glory, Jesus, is constantly praying for us. Our prayer is that we, in God's own time, may be with Him in paradise.
