# Reflection Our Goals:Faith, Unity and Eternal Life

Today, the 7th Sunday of Easter, focuses on faith, unity, and eternal life. The readings highlight the steadfastness of Stephen, the prayer of Jesus for unity among believers, and the invitation to eternal life. These themes guide us to deepen our faith, strengthen our community, and embrace God's grace.

In the first reading, Stephen is full of faith and the Holy Spirit. Even when facing death, he does not waver. He forgives those who are stoning him, just like Jesus did on the cross. Stephen's faith and forgiveness are examples for us. We can learn from Stephen to stand firm in our faith, even when it is hard. Sometimes, we may face challenges or people who do not understand our faith. In the Gospel, Jesus prays for all believers to be united. He prays that we may be one just as He and the Father are one. Jesus wants us to love one another and work together. When we are united, we reflect God's love and build a stronger Church and community. We can work towards unity by supporting and caring for each other. Praying together, helping those in need, and showing kindness are ways to build unity. The second reading talks about Jesus offering the water of life freely. This invitation is open to everyone. It shows God's desire for all people to have eternal life. This means God's grace is available to all, without exception. We can accept this invitation by sharing the good news with others and inviting them to know Jesus.
