Fifth Sunday of Easter



love and faith in the face of Betrayal - young-catholics.com

On the 5th Sunday of Easter Year C, we reflect on the themes of love and faith found in the readings. At this point in the Gospel of John, Jesus and His disciples are in Jerusalem for the Passover. Jesus is aware of His impending betrayal by Judas and the plots against Him. Despite this, Jesus chooses to speak about love and service, showing His trust in the Father. In the reading from Acts, Paul and Barnabas encourage the early Church to remain strong in their faith. They show us the importance of community and support. In the face of hardships, they continue to spread the Gospel, teaching us that faith and perseverance go hand in hand.

The passage from Revelation offers hope with the vision of a new heaven and a new earth. It reminds us that God is with us, wiping away our tears and promising a future free of pain and suffering. This vision encourages us to hold on to our faith, knowing that God is always near.

Finally, Jesus 'new commandment to love one another as He has loved us is a powerful message for the 5th Sunday of Easter Year C. Despite knowing He would be betrayed, Jesus focuses on love and service. His example teaches us to love others even in difficult times and to trust in God's plan.

Everyone from South-East Hampshire Pastoral Area is encouraged and invited to celebrate this one Sunday Mass on the feast of Pentecost. We look forward to rejoicing in the birthday of the Church, as well as meeting other people from our wider community and to hear the Bishop's affirmation of the new parish name. We thank all those of you who have joined in the discernment process and expect the name to be one of the following:

Shroud of Turin Exhibition comes to Portsmouth

An exhibition around one of the most famous religious artefacts in history is coming to St John's Cathedral Portsmouth from **1st-14th June**. The exhibition, recently in St. George's Cathedral, Southwark, London contains life-sized replicas of the Shroud of Turin. The Shroud is a length of linen cloth which bears a faint image of the front and back of a crucified man. Many believe it is the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus of Nazareth after his crucifixion, and upon which his bodily image is miraculously imprinted. New scientific evidence suggests the Shroud is a 1st century cloth. The exhibition will also feature other displays and detailed information boards, which cover evidence revealed by historical and scientific research, explaining how the Shroud's image and bloodstains align with Gospel accounts. There is an information poster later on in this newsletter.

Admittance to Hospital?

When a Catholic is admitted to hospital, the family should ensure that the Catholic Chaplaincy is contacted so that appropriate support can be given. It is suggested that the patient have a note to give to hospital staff on admission, notifying staff that they are Catholic and would appreciate the Catholic Chaplaincy service. This could be followed up by a telephone call from the family to the ward to ensure the request is actioned. When a person is due to go into hospital, please also let your parish priest know so that he can administer the Sacrament of the Sick where appropriate.


