**Revelation 21:10-14.22-23** We are given a majestic picture of the new Jerusalem, the heavenly Church of the future, when God's kingdom will come in all its glory.

John 14:23-29 We hear another part of Jesus' farewell discourse at the Last Supper. It is dominated by the thought of his imminent departure.

The Ascension of the Lord, Raphael, 1483-1520

Acts 1:1-11 We hear of the ascension of Jesus into heaven, and of his promise to send the Holy Spirit to his disciples.

**Ephesians 1:16-23** Paul sets out the meaning of the ascension: God raised Jesus above all earthly creatures, and made him the head of the Church and Lord of creation.

<u>Luke 24:46-53</u> Before ascending into heaven, Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit to his disciples.
