# Habemus Papam!



With great excitement and joy many gathered in St Peter's Square, and millions more, tuned in from around the world through television and live streams, as white smoke plumed from the Sistine chapel with the peel of bells signifying that the successor of St Peter, the 267<sup>th</sup> Pope in history had been elected by the cardinals. Appearing on the balcony of St Peter's Basilica the crowds were greeted for the first time by the newly elected Pope Leo XIV, the papal name taken by Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost. He is the first Augustinian Pope, being a priest and missionary in the Order of Saint Augustine, who served for many years the peoples in Peru. From 2023 until 2025 he worked in the Vatican as Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops. It is being much commented upon that Cardinal Prevost, now Pope Leo XIV, is the first Pope from North America, being a native of Chicago and born in 1955, though he also holds Peruvian citizenship. For many, his election came

as a surprise and I am sure we will be hearing and learning a lot more about our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV. After greeting the crowds with words of peace and unity, he asked for the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Our Lady of Pompeii, saying, "Our blessed mother Mary always wants to walk with us, be close to us, she always wants to help us with her intercession and her love. So let us pray together for this mission, and for all of the Church, and for peace in the world. We ask for this special grace from Mary, our Mother."

After leading the crowd in praying the *Hail Mary* he imparted a solemn blessing upon the city of Rome and upon the entire world. Let us pray for our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, and *may the Lord preserve him, give him long life, make him blessed upon the earth, and not hand him over to the power of his enemies. Lord may your hand be upon your holy servant. And upon your son, whom you have anointed. Amen.*
