REFLECTION

Living in the Light of the Ascension


The Ascension of Jesus is not just a moment of departure-it's a moment of deep promise. It marks the end of Jesus' visible ministry on earth, but the beginning of something even more intimate: his presence within us through the Holy Spirit.

Luke's Gospel tells us that Jesus was lifted up into heaven before the eyes of his disciples. It's a powerful image, but its meaning reaches far beyond the sky. The Ascension invites us to see that Jesus has not left us behind-he has gone ahead of us, opening the way to the Father and making room for us in the life of God.

In the silence after Jesus ascended, the disciples were not left in sorrow. They waited in hope for what Jesus promised-the Holy Spirit, the presence of God not just with them, but within them. That promise is for us, too. The same Spirit Jesus sent now lives in us, guiding, comforting, and empowering us to be his hands and feet in the world.

The Ascension also reminds us that our faith is not just about what happened in the past, but about what is still to come. Jesus will return in glory. Until then, we are called to live with purpose-carrying his love, proclaiming his truth, and trusting that he is always near, even when we cannot see him.

So today, don't just look up—look within. Christ has ascended, but he has not abandoned us. His Spirit fills our hearts. His mission continues through us. And his promise still stands: "I am with you always."



Lord Jesus, thank You for completing Your work on earth and opening the way for us to share in Your life. Help me to live today in the power of Your Spirit, trusting that You are always near. As I wait for Your return, may I be faithful in the mission You've given me—to love, to serve, and to witness to Your glory. Amen.

29th of May - Thursday is the solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. This is a Holy Day of Obligation. In the Catholic church, a Holy Day of Obligation is a special day set aside for the faithful to attend Mass and participate more fully in the life of the Church. These days are not just obligations, but wonderful opportunities to celebrate the key mysteries of our faith. They draw us deeper into the life of Christ and His Church.
