Sunday 4 May 2025 : Third Sunday of Easter

In this Sunday's Gospel reading, St John tells us about the third time the Risen Lord was revealed to the disciples, at the Sea of Galilee. John's choice of language – "revealed" – is significant: we are being told that the Paschal Mystery of the Lord's death and resurrection needs to be revealed to us. For the disciples, this revelation came about by signs: at first they see a figure on the shore, and it is the sign of a miraculous draught of fish which reveals the truth to John – "it is the Lord!". Then the breaking and sharing of bread – that most characteristic action of Jesus – completes the picture for the disciples. Finally, for Simon Peter especially, there is a further revelation: the Lord of Mercy accepts Peter's imperfections and his limited capacity to love, and in return renews Peter with strength for his mission.
