15th June 2025 AD Year C (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Today we welcome Fr David Conroy, who has come to celebrate mass for us. The Wisdom of God existed before the universe came into being. Jesus promises us the Holy Spirit of God our Father, who will lead us into the fullness of truth. The Spirit has poured the love of God into our hearts and leads us into a deeper understanding of what the Gospel of Christ really means.
