Year C (Psalter Week 4)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Each one of us has a share in the priesthood of Jesus through Baptism and the Holy Spirit. Every time we eat His Body and drink His Blood we proclaim the power of His Death and Resurrection and we continue to do this until He comes again. The Eucharist is more than a memorial celebration of a past event. The Eucharist is a continuing sacrament that effectively flows into our hearts and into our lives constantly—an unending sacrifice for you and for me.

First Reading:	Genesis 14:18-20 — He offered bread and wine
Responsorial Psalm:	You are a priest for ever, according to the order f Melchizedek. (Psalm 110)
Second Reading:	Corinthians 11:23-26 — For as often as you eat and drink, you proclaim the Lord's death
Gospel Acclamation:	Alleluia, alleluia! I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live for ever. Alleluia! (John 6:51)
Gospel Reading:	Luke 9:11b-17 — All ate and were satisfied
Communion Antiphon:	Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord. (John 6:57)
