Sunday 8 June 2025 : Pentecost

Pentecost is the birthday of the Church, the anniversary of the gift of the Holy Spirit from heaven to the Apostles and other disciples, gathered in the upper room in Jerusalem with Mary the Mother of Jesus. The Cenacle where Jesus instituted the Eucharist becomes the place where the Church gathers for the first time, convened by the Holy Spirit and constituted into the Mystical Body of Christ. Immediately, the Church's missionary nature is apparent, from the proclamation of the Gospel by the Apostles in every language. What better day to celebrate the inauguration of our new Parish Area of South-East Hampshire? Let us gather at Oaklands Catholic School this afternoon, to celebrate our diversity with music, language and dress, and to celebrate our unity by offering together the Holy Eucharist!
