Sunday 29 June 2025 : Saints Peter and Paul

Jesus says "on this Rock I will build my Church" (Matthew 16:18). What is your mental image of the rock and the church? The Vatican Basilica on its hill? This image would not have been available to Jesus' first disciples, for whom this saying must have been ambiguous at first. How could he build a congregation or assembly of people ("ecclesia") on a rock? (Compare to parable of the builders in Matthew 7:24-27.) The rock to which Jesus refers is the faith Peter ("Rock") expresses: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." We share this faith, which is the foundation uniting us into one building, one Body of Christ, the Catholic Church.
