### 1. Overall Job Purpose

Development of, and to increase the awareness of music within local church/pastoral area and to provide music for liturgies.

The postholder is expected to foster a professional, welcoming, and efficient parish environment for parishioners, volunteers, and visitors.

Where necessary, to support the liturgical music development of other churches in the pastoral area.
