PENTECOST SUNDAY

Fr. Jeremy writes... "Peace Be With You"



'Peace perfect peace is the gift of Christ the Lord', as the popular hymn goes. Peace is very much a theme of Pentecost. The Holy Spirit is a symbol of peace, Jesus is sometimes described as Prince of Peace since peace is what he bequeathes to his disciples after the resurrection, his legacy to the infant Church. Writing of today's Gospel, Henry Wansborough, the scripture scholar, notes that: 'In the Gospel today, Jesus brings peace to his disciples with the double greeting of peace, and peace is a Christian watchword. Peace was the song of the angels at Jesus' birth. Each of Paul's letters opens with a greeting of peace. The letter to the Ephesians proclaims that Christ is our peace, the reversal of all worry, strife, envy, jealousy, self-seeking ambition. 'Go in peace' is Jesus' dismissal of those he cures, and also the dismissal at the end of Mass. Peace was Jesus' bequest to his disciples after the Last Supper'.

Peace was also the greeting first made by Pope Leo to the Church and the world when he first stepped onto the balcony of St Peter's after his election, and peace is, as always, sorely lacking in our world today with the vicious conflict between Israelis and Palestinians, the war between Russia and Ukraine, war torn Sudan and the various other conflicts around the world. There is no more urgent work for us as Christians to do now than pray for peace so that more innocent victims lives may not be lost and food and humanitarian aid may reach those starving and dying in war zones.

When a person is due to go into hospital, please also let your parish priest know so that he can administer the Sacrament of the Sick where appropriate.

Shroud of Turin Exhibition comes to Portsmouth

An exhibition around one of the most famous religious artefacts in history is coming to St John's Cathedral Portsmouth from **1-14 June**. The exhibition, recently in St. George's Cathedral, Southwark, London contains life-sized replicas of the Shroud of Turin. The Shroud is a length of linen cloth which bears a faint image of the front and back of a crucified man. Many believe it is the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus of Nazareth after his crucifixion, and upon which his bodily image is miraculously imprinted. New scientific evidence suggests the Shroud is a 1st century cloth. The exhibition will also feature other displays and detailed information boards, which cover evidence revealed by historical and scientific research, explaining how the Shroud's image and bloodstains align with Gospel accounts.
