Amare Memoriae Canon Gerard Flynn

Canon Gerard first began his career as a primary school teacher in 1974 to 1994, with the enthusiasm and energy that he displayed throughout his life. His love of that vocation rapidly led to headship, only to have a life-saving liver transplant take him in another direction-the priesthood.

He studied first at Allen Hall and then at the Venerable English College before he was ordained to the priesthood on 21st November 1999 at Christ the King, Reading by Bishop Crispian Hollis. He spent nearly two years at St James and St William of York, Reading as Assistant Priest before becoming Parish Priest of Christ the King where he stayed until 2007. He was then made Parish Priest of St Saviour, Totland and St Thomas of Canterbury, Newport on the Isle of Wight until 2015. He was also Coordinating Pastor for the Isle of Wight Pastoral Area from 2010 to 2015. He was Parish Priest of St Michael and All Angels for 10 years.

Canon Gerard was made a Canon to the Cathedral Chapter in October 2018 and Vocations Director for twenty years, from 2004.

His love and appreciation of both his parishioners and the liturgy was ever present. In particular, his desire to serve and help those in challenging situations with quiet kindness and grace, or to rejoice in celebration of the faith and life's joys. Despite the pressures of illness throughout his later life, he managed to fulfil his vocation to his last days with wisdom and spirit. In many ways very private, he remained open to all those God sent to him, enriching their lives with his faith, humanity and love. His immediate friends and family will miss him sorely.

This year's theme, 'Finding Meaning in Suffering – Hope Does Not Disappoint', draws on St Paul's words in Romans 5:5-6, reminding us that Christian hope is not mere optimism, but an unshakeable trust in God's presence — even amid the darkest trials of illness, grief, or emotional pain.</p> <p>The 2025 Day for Life comes at a crucial time as the Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill — commonly known as the Assisted Dying Bill — is making its way through Parliament. This proposed legislation would permit adults with mental capacity, diagnosed as terminally ill and within six months of death, to request medical assistance to end their lives. Assisted Suicide – Calling for urgent help this weekend!

Catherine Robinson from the Right to Life charity writes...

As you may be aware, the final and decisive vote on the Leadbeater Assisted Suicide Bill is now just 13 days away - on Friday 20 June.

If just 28 MPs switch from supporting assisted suicide to opposing it, the Bill falls. Some have already switched, so this Bill can be defeated.

As part of our final phase of the campaign against the Bill, we have launched a **stand-alone petition in your constituency, to your local MP**. You can view it online here: www.righttolife.org.uk/petitions.

A petition signed by a strong number of local people urging your MP to vote against the Bill will carry real weight. It's undeniable proof that many in the constituency want their MP to turn up on 20 June and vote NO to assisted suicide.

A flood of signatures from your parish and others nearby could help tip the balance and stop this dangerous Bill in its tracks.
