Year C (Psalter Week 2)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Divine Peace is our theme. Pope Leo XIV's first word to the crowds on the day that he was elected pope was "Peace". Our new Parish Name is to be "St Patrick's Church in the Parish of Jesus, Prince of Peace". It is Peace that we seek, both an inner and outer peace that the world cannot give. We'll never be able to stop all the wars in the world—they are caused by sin—but the Gospel message is one of peace and, as we celebrate 100 years of our Church building on Hayling Island, we are to bring Christ's peace to His people. We do this through engagement with Jesus' suffering and resurrection. In this way, we lead a new life and peace will flow like a river to everyone around us.

Gospel Reading:	John 10:1-12,17-20 — <i>Your peace will rest upon him</i>
Communion Antiphon:	Taste and see that the LORD is good; blest the man who seeks refuge in Him. (Psalm 33:9)
