Year C (Psalter Week)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. The commandment to love our neighbour as ourselves is one of the most well known, and popular, sayings of Jesus. But Jesus makes it clear that our 'neighbour' is not simply the person next door. It is well to remember that God is as near to us as our own heart. If we wish to be Christ-like (the very meaning of the word 'Christian') then we will serve all people without distinction. We will become reconcilers and love God with all our heart. In this way, Christians become the Good Samaritans of our beaten and wounded world.
