Year C (Psalter Week 3) 20th July 2025 AD

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Today's Gospel reading can be, at first glance, a little confusing. Mary and Martha both welcome Jesus into their home but in different ways. Martha was anxious to show hospitality and prepare a meal; Mary, however, chose to keep Him company, listening to all He had to say. We need to find the balance in our lives so that we are never too busy to listen to Jesus with love. It is love that opens our heart to His message when He comes to share His life with us.
