The Mission of the Disciples

Shaking the sand from your sandals may seem like a rather petty reaction to rejection. In doing so the person is declaring: 'I do not want share anything, not even the same earth, as you!' This sort of reaction might seem a bit odd and yet it was what the Lord instructed his disciples to do.

Within the context of his commissioning of the seventy-two disciples, Jesus is making it clear that rejection and hostility will be a large part of spreading the Gospel.

His 'sand-shaking' advice is not intended as a snub to those who reject the Good News but rather as a lesson for his disciples. We will constantly come in contact with people, who find the truth of the Gospel abhorrent and risible. One has only to think of the 'new atheists', Islamists and secularists who are growing in numbers within the Western world.

When we interact with these people, we ought not to let ourselves be dragged down to merely negative and aggressive engagement. We should not make 'winning the argument' the main objective. Whilst never losing our zeal or our openness we have to constantly shake off the 'sands of negativity' that comes with rejection and continue with our evangelical calling. If we allow the 'sands of negativity' to weigh us down, we will end up struggling to complete our mission: so, shake off the sand!
