How do we think about the sacred? Sometimes the distinction between sacred and profane can serve as a means of containing God within safe limits – his realm is deemed to be the religious, and what is outside of church can be the world's, or our own. Jesus' actions in today's Gospel challenge that easy distinction: he sends his disciples ahead of him to the places he wants to go, places that are not always safe. He sends them in a way which signifies the breaking out of the kingdom of God from the realm of the religious and sacred into the world of human life. How do we take holiness out from our sacred space to sanctify the world?
