Sunday 20 July 2025 : Sixteenth Sunday of the Year

In this Sunday's Gospel we meet two of Jesus' friends: Mary of Bethany and her sister Martha. They are quite different characters! I'm guessing that Martha is the responsible older sister who gets things done, while Mary is the day-dreaming younger sister, organised by Martha. Martha wants Jesus to back up her demand that Mary pull her weight, but Jesus affirms Mary for who she is, and even says that Mary has got it right by putting being before doing. We meet the same two sisters in John 11, where Jesus raises their brother Lazarus from the dead. Both sisters receive their brother back from the grave, but Jesus has a different way of consoling each of them in their grief: for Martha it is the chance to talk through her faith that helps her, but for Mary Jesus sees that she needs him to share in her sorrow: "Jesus wept".
