Fr. Jeremy Writes – for the last time!

Dear parishioners and friends, what an amazing celebration you gave me for my fiftieth anniversary of ordination last Saturday, and my farewell party at St Edmund's the Sunday before. In spite of the sorrow underlying it, the events were also joyful and full of love, and I think this sums up the contrasting emotions I feel right now as I write: I am happy to retire as I am wearing out – joints getting stiffer, waistline getting broader, wrinkles getting deeper, hairline getting thinner, mind getting spongier, etc., but I am also very sad to be leaving behind the people I love who have given my life such radiant meaning over the past eight and a half years. You have kept me young as long as possible and now I must be put out to pasture to reflect on how good God has been to me in my life as a priest. As Mr Quinn said in one of his many farewell speeches as Headteacher of Oaklands, there comes a time when you know it's right to go, that you have given what you can and its time for someone with new insights and ideas to take on the challenge. In my case, that person is Fr James, and I am delighted he is staying on here as I leave. The parish is in capable hands and I know he will continue to carry on the good work we have both been engaged in over the past three years, though, as I've said before, he's done most of the heavy lifting. I cannot thank him enough.



I have been overwhelmed by the kindness and generosity of you all. I have been inundated with so many wonderful cards with lovely words of tribute and thanks, and I have lost count of the number of bottles of very good quality wines and spirits you have bestowed on me – certainly enough to keep me happy for the next fifty years, in the unlikely event that I should live that long, and, if not, to preserve my body incorrupt for eternity. As for cakes, I think the count was nine when I last looked, enough to open a teashop for the passing trade. I have had spiritual bouquets with pledges of Masses, rosaries and prayers to be said for me – and I will need them!

I have also received practical gifts for my new home and even a new pair of braces all the way from China to hold my trousers up as the Mounjaro injections continue to kick in.

Please forgive me if I offer you all a blanket – but no less sincere – thank you for all your gifts and cards and also the kindnesses and words of gratitude expressed verbally when we have met. I was stunned speechless by the very generous gifts of money you contributed to my presentation – a whopping £1,020 from St Edmund's and £3,050 from Sacred Heart in cheques plus a number of gifts of cash on top. God bless you all for your wonderful and overwhelming generosity of spirit. My thanks to all who gave their time, energy and expertise in one way or another to the wonderful Excelsis Golden Harmony Concert, to the family fun day at St Edmund's and the Mass and attendant reception for my jubilee. Again, your generosity has been overwhelming.



Finally, but by no means least, my thanks to all those who have assisted me in my work here as parish priest. I have had a dream team of employees who have been more than employees, they have been friends and have given their time and their talents generously and way beyond the call of duty. These are Sue, Lisa, Nina, Yvonne and Angela. Add to these the small army of volunteers who have given time and talent to all the activities of a busy parish: cleaners, flower arrangers, sacristans, altar servers, readers, catechists, children's liturgy organisers, members of committees, clubs and groups, refreshment organisers, stewards, gardeners, dog-walkers, odd job volunteers, technical advisers,

equipment operators... and so the list goes on.

Thank you all so much for showing me how the life of Christ flourishes in a truly Christian community like ours here. Thank you, goodbye, God bless and be assured of my prayers for you all each day.
