# fr. Tom Hiney writes...

Fr. Tom isn't with us yet, but he has very kindly agreed to submit a 'Fr. Tom writes...' for the newsletter:

### WHAT IS PRAYER?

I have been asked to address this theme by a small group that has recently started at the Cathedral, calling themselves 'Finding Faith'. They are a combination of baptised Catholics who are rediscovering the faith, often for the first time since childhood, and those discovering the Church for the first time.

Foremost among those treasures is the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (1992), the final chapter of which answers this very question beautifully, opening with a timeless definition from St Therese of Lisieux: "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy'.

Prayer, we are told, is not something we get good at like gardening, and it is not to do with feelings. Even saints were not in ecstasy all the time. It is more like a friendship, which deepens with trust and over time. We must not always be on 'Send', but also on 'Receive', listening. It is brutal at times, because we cannot quieten our conscience in prayer.

To pray is to embark on a lifetime of sanctification, of yearning to be holier, so that one can know this loving God more closely, be united to Him more inseparably. We are, as Jesus says, speaking with a Father, be it in petition, praise, contrition or pure adoration. Overcoming distraction is not a technique, but an act of love.

I am very looking forward to joining you all from September 8<sup>th</sup> – See you soon!
