Year C (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Today's Gospel contains a stark warning from Jesus. We cannot think that being a "Roman Catholic" makes us better than others or gives us automatic entry into heaven. Faith is not "a tick-box exercise". Jesus says that others may find their way into God's kingdom before us—it is not for us to judge who is worthy. Because of our Baptism and Confirmation and our reception of the Most Holy Sacrament, we are called to set ourselves higher standards and to seek to enter the kingdom by the narrow door.
