Year C (Psalter Week 2)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. Today's Scriptures call us to be humble; God's blessing is bestowed on those who behave in an humble manner. Jesus teaches us not to seek status and honours from other people. It is in being humble, like Jesus who gave Himself up in humility, that we find favour with God. Jesus will lead us to the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God, if only we follow Him in humility and with faith.
