## CENTENARY CELEBRATION OF ST PATRICK'S CHURCH, HAYLING ISLAND

### 21st September 2025 AD

Year C (Psalter Week 1)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. At mass today we celebrate, along with the Resurrection of Jesus, our 100th year as a Church Community here on Hayling Island. Today Bishop Philip Egan joins us, just as Bishop William Cotter caused the church to be built, Bishop Derek Warlock celebrated our 50th year and Bishop Anthony Emery consecrated the building forty-one years ago. This continuity of Bishops mirrors the continuity of our Catholic Christian faith—people change, events take place, but the Gospel of Jesus and the Rock upon which our faith stands remain the same.

1 Kings 8:22-23,27-30 — Your eyes may be open towards this house First Reading:
