Year C (Psalter Week 2)

Welcome to St Patrick's Church. In our Gospel reading today we hear a stark warning about the pursuit of earthly riches. In His parable, Jesus warns that the rich man is punished, not for his wealth, but for his indifference to the poor—one of whom lay hungry on his very doorstep. We are called to share what we have with those who nothing. In the same way we are all called to share the riches of our faith in Jesus with those who do not know Him.

Amos 6:1a,4-7 — The revelry of those who now stretch themselves out shall pass away+ First Reading:

Responsorial Psalm: My soul, give praise the LORD! (Psalm 146)

Second Reading: Timothy 6:11b-16 — The whole structure grows into a holy temple of the Lord

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia!

Jesus Christ, though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor,

So that you by His poverty might become rich.

Alleluia! (2 Corinthians 8:9)

Gospel Reading: Luke 16:19-31 — You received good things, and Lazarus bad things, now he is comforted here...
