Sunday 14 September 2025 : The Exaltation of the Holy Cross

St Paul's words in today's second reading (Philippians 2:6-11) about the exaltation of Jesus through his death on the cross must have seemed strange, even scandalous, to his original ancient readers, for whom the cross was a sign of terror, a symbol of the power of empire to impose a terrible death. But for Jesus it is the instrument of salvation, by which we see the God who "so loves the world" (John 3:16). Jesus points to the prophecy of the bronze serpent in our first reading (Numbers 21:4-9) to show that the mystery of his death and resurrection takes the very symbol of death and transforms it to become a sign of life and hope: the Cross.
