#### Incense

In response to requests from a couple of parishioners we have recently changed to using incense at mass which has no additives. It is pure frankincense and is therefore considered to be hypoallergenic. The use of incense in the liturgy goes back to its earliest days. The smoke of incense is symbolic of solemnity, sanctification and purification. It also symbolises the prayers of the faithful rising to heaven. Using incense in the liturgy calls to mind the incense burnt in the Temple at Jerusalem and serves as a visible reminder of God's presence, linking earthly worship to heavenly glory. Please note that incense is only used at the 9.30 mass on Sundays and at funerals. If the burning of incense remains a problem then may we suggest attending the 11.00 mass on Sundays.
